- The Committee has the power to take disciplinary action against those who indulge in ragging, which may include expulsion from the institution, suspension, or fine.
- The Committee provides counseling to students who have been victims of ragging or witnessed ragging, to help them cope with the trauma and recover from the experience.
- The Committee monitors the institution to ensure that the anti-ragging policies and guidelines are being followed and implemented effectively.



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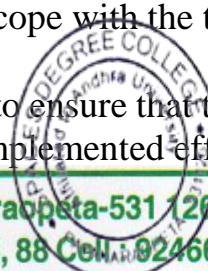

- To provide free working environment for all the students and staff members by conducting seminars and guest lectures.




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
